

Iglu Regional Scholarship Guidelines

IGLU REGIONAL SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

The Iglu Regional Scholarship is a scholarship program that enables students from regional Australia and New Zealand to stay at Iglu properties across Sydney, Brisbane or Melbourne while they are studying at an Iglu partner university or other tertiary institution.

The scholarship which assists with the cost of accommodation is established and administered in accordance with the following conditions.

1. TITLE

The scholarship is called the Iglu Regional Scholarship.

2. PURPOSE

The purpose of the scholarship is to offer deserving students from regional Australia and New Zealand an opportunity to stay at an Iglu property whilst they are they are studying at an Iglu partner university or other tertiary institution in Sydney, Brisbane or Melbourne.

3. BENEFITS AND TENURE

The benefits and length of the Iglu Regional Scholarship program are as follows:

- a. subject to clause 3 (c) below, where available, one scholarship of a residential agreement at reduced rent at an Iglu property will be allocated for one year* in an agreed apartment type. Except for rental obligations, the awardee will have the same rights and obligations as other residents at Iglu and be required to comply with the same Residential Agreement and House Rules as other residents.
- b. the duration of each scholarship will be one year*.
- c. the benefit (i.e. reduced rent) of each scholarship will be clearly notified and explained to the awardee at time of award.

4. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

In order to receive a scholarship, the awardee must:

- a. be an Australian or New Zealand citizen or permanent resident;
- b. be currently living in regional Australia or New Zealand;
- c. be graduating Year 12 in 2023 or have graduated in 2022;
- d. be enrolled or about to be enrolled at an Iglu partner university or any other tertiary institution in Sydney, Brisbane or Melbourne;
- e. be intending to commence tertiary studies in 2024
- f. be a new customer to Iglu.

^{*} A one year contract is equivalent to 12 months in Brisbane and Melbourne and 44 weeks in Sydney.

5. CONDITIONS OF AWARD

The Iglu Regional Scholarship is awarded in line with the following terms and conditions:

- a. the student must remain enrolled at their university or other tertiary institution for the duration of their lease with Iglu. Exclusion from their university or other tertiary institution or discontinuation of their course will result in the termination of the scholarship (refer to clause 7 (c)).
- b. the student must adhere to the Residential Agreement and Iglu House Rules.

6. SELECTION

The awardee will be selected by Iglu.

- a. The scholarship offer must be accepted in writing and each awardee must agree to the Conditions of the Award.
- b. Acceptance of this scholarship may mean the awardee does not qualify for certain other forms of Commonwealth assistance intended for the same or similar purpose.

7. TERMINATION

An award of a scholarship to an individual may be terminated or suspended if the awardee:

- a. commits a breach of the Residential Agreement and/or House Rules resulting in termination of the Agreement;
- b. does not maintain enrolment in their university or other tertiary institution course;
- c. is excluded by their university other tertiary institution from the course/study units due to academic failure, or because of misconduct (as defined by the institution); or
- d. is unable to continue a program due to serious illness or incapacity for medical/mental health reasons.

8. PRIVACY

An awardee's privacy will be respected. However, disclosure of information will sometimes be required to enable operation of the Iglu Regional Scholarship. The awardee acknowledges that the purpose of any such exchange or disclosure of personal information is to:

- a. enable Iglu to promote/advertise the scholarship; and
- b. allow Iglu to conduct normal business operations (in accordance with the Iglu Student Accommodation Privacy Policy).
